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

19-04-2016	S.16/0836/COU	Churchend Nurseries Churchend Eastington	Proposed development to include alterations and repairs to existing mill building into a single residential dwelling (Change of use to residential). Development to include the demolition of existing timber, steel and glass derelict green house structures, structural repairs necessary to retain existing structures and roofs. Minor alterations to facade for new glazing to existing openings. Proposal to also include a two story contemporary extension and a store for machinery/tools.
