

# **CHARLIE BULLOCK FUND**

## **MINUTES**

Meeting of the Trustees of The Charlie Bullock Fund on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2017, held at 6.00pm in the Eastington Village Hall:

1. **Attendance** Cllrs Bullock (Chair), Chatterley, Corrie, Loveridge, Simmons and Wells.
2. **Declarations of interest** Cllr Corrie declared an interest in the PROWD grant application.
3. **Minutes of the previous meeting** The Minutes of the meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2017 were approved.
4. **To consider the following grant applications:**
  - Public Rights of Way Defenders. The Trustees discussed the application and felt that it was an important project to support. Cllr Chatterley would like to see at least one full path replaced with something more accessible than kissing gates so that those with pushchairs, electric scooters etc could also access the countryside. The grant application is for the purchase of kissing gates, installation is to be met through other means. It was noted that that PROWD do not have a bank account as per the grant criteria. There was also no evidence to demonstrate match funding has been sought. It was agreed to ask PROWD to review the application for consideration in March 2018. Action: Clerk.
  - Owen Harris Memorial Ground Charity. Concerns were raised that the ball net fencing would benefit sports teams such as West Bromwich that are not from the local community so does not meet the grant criteria. The grant application was turned down.
