Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 22nd September 2015 at 7.00pm in Eastington Methodist Hall

- 1 **Attendance and apologies for absence** In attendance Cllrs Bullock (Chair), Corrie, Loveridge, and Simmons. There were 3 members of the public. Cllr Bomberg was absent.
- 2 **Declarations of interest in items on the agenda.** None.
- 3 **Cllr Bullock was proposed as Committee Chair by Cllr Corrie and seconded by Cllr Loveridge;** this was agreed by all.

The meeting was adjourned at this point for members of the Public to speak.

Mrs Pitcher noted the condition of Alkerton Cross and that the weeding around the Cross needed doing; Cllr Loveridge responded this was due to be carried out soon. Cllr Corrie asked the members of public what they thought of the Flower Tower, and this was well received but noted that Stonehouse had taller arrangements.
