

4. Community Governance Review Consultation:

- 4.1 To receive report from SPWG on the Community Governance Review of the Stroud District Phase 1 Consultation Survey
- 4.2 To note that Stonehouse Town Council are still keen to press ahead with a request for an enlarged parish boundary and to agree a response to their initial thoughts, which are to include the following parcels of land which are to be developed under the West of Stonehouse projects: H19, H18, H20, H16, H17, PS1, LC2, LC1, E1, E3, E2 (taken from the indicative masterplan drawing dated 24 March 2014), excluding any parts which might form part of the Nastend hamlet. This follows a natural boundary line.
- 4.3 To discuss and agree response, with reasons, to phase 1 of the consultation. Would the council benefit from exploring any of the following options?:
 - Increasing or decreasing the number of Parish/Town Councillors
 - Merging or splitting your Parish/Town Council
 - Creating or changing your existing Parish ward boundaries (if applicable)
 - Changing the name of your Parish/Town Council
 - Grouping or de-grouping together with a neighbouring Parish/Town Council
 - Changing the style of your Parish/Town Council (e.g from a Parish Council to a Town Council)
 - Abolishing your parish so that it becomes an un-parished area.
